Due to limited places for our Vacation Care Program we are following the Priority of Access Guidelines

Priority of Access

The Australian Government has determined Priority of Access Guidelines for allocating places in childcare services. These guidelines set out the following three levels of priority:

Priority 1 – A child at serious risk of abuse or neglect.

Priority 2 – A child of a single parent or 2 parent family which satisfies the work / training / study test under Section 14 of the Family Assistance Act:

- Children in Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander families.
- Children in families which includes a disabled person.
- Children in families on lower incomes (School Card).
- Children in families from a non-english speaking background.
- Children in socially isolated families.
- Children of single parents.

Priority 3 – Any other child.
